



## Hall Rental Rules

---

All cheques are to be made out to "Grand Lake Oakfield Community Society".

To guarantee your booking, a \$100 security deposit cheque is required. It will be returned after the event, if the hall is in the same condition it was before the event.

Renters will pay for set up and clean up unless they do it themselves.

All rental fees (Hall, Kitchen, Bar, Setup and Cleanup) have to be paid on or before the day of the event.

The fire safety occupancy limit is not to exceed 150 people.

Burning of candles is permitted during ceremonial portions of the event only.

No balls, water fights or projectiles are allowed in the hall.

No tacks, nails, tape, pushpins or staples are to be used on the walls.

No marking on the walls by any means is permitted.

There is to be no parking directly in front of the hall on Lakeside Drive and two car lengths in either direction or on either side of the tarmac of the fire department (please see attached diagram).

There is no smoking inside the building; smokers must be 200 meters from any entrance to the building.

Standard health and fire safety procedures and Liquor Board regulations apply to all events.

Seasonal rates are available for regular bookings (ie. local groups with the same hours and week day for several months).

The GLOCS reserves the right to cancel any facility rental either prior to or during such rental and/or order all persons out or off the premises do to operational concerns, emergency, or failure of the Renter to comply with the rental terms.

The GLOCS is not responsible for any damages sustained by the Renter as a result of the cancellation.

Any persons in the building associated with your group are the responsibility of the Renter.

Renters are financially responsible for any damage to rental space/equipment or property.

Renters are to be in the designated areas only. The rest of the building is out of bounds.
